What you will need:

Pritt products

- Glue Gun and Sticks
- Metal Glue
- PVA Glue



Materials

- Foam balls
- Vintage beads
- Patterned animal wrapping paper
- Kebab skewer
- Varnish
- Tweezers
- Metal plain hair slides
- Jewellery thread
- Small paint brush
- Metal wire
- Pliers
- Hair slides/clips



Necklace

1. Thread the foam balls of your chosen size onto the kebab sticks. Cut the printed wrapping paper into strips and using the PVA glue cover each of the balls.
2. Once covered, paint with clear varnish to seal them and leave to dry.
3. When dry add a few more thinner strips of paper to add texture. Do not cover the whole of the ball.
4. Thread some of your old beads (3-5 depending on their size) onto the jewellery thread and secure the ends to make small rings of beads.
5. Remove the decorated foam balls from the kebab sticks. Add these and the bead rings to the metal in your chosen pattern.
6. When finished bend the ends of the metal so that you can link them together to secure the necklace.

Hair Slides/Clips

1. Using a selection of old beads; e.g. ones you have collected, or an old necklace from a charity shop and separate the beads from the string and place into a bowl.
2. Starting at one end of the slide/clip, place a small amount of glue, roughly the same size of your first bead.
3. Repeat this process all the way along the slide/clip.
4. Place the bead in the correct position and press down firmly.

Handy Tips

- Pull off all the wisps of glue (they look like hair!). Once it has dried, they snap off easier when cool.
- Spend time on the beads it's important to get these right.

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
